Vaccine Recommendations for Kittens and Adult Cats

- ❖ We begin the kitten series between 6 and 8 weeks of age. The following chart will show what should be given and when.

6-8 weeks	<u>Fvr-cp</u>	(Distemper Combo)
9-11 weeks	<u>Fvr-cp/Felv</u>	(Distemper Combo & Leukemia)
12-14 weeks	<u>Fvr-cp/FelV</u>	(Distemper Combo & Leukemia)
15-17 weeks	<u>Fvr-cp</u>	(Distemper Combo)
16 weeks or older	<u>Rabies</u>	(Rabies)

- ❖ Cats under a year, but past the age for the kitten series should be given a series of two on the Fvr-cp/Felv vaccinations.
- ❖ Rabies is given to cats at 16 weeks or older. (This is highly recommended for outdoor cats, but is not required by law.)
- ❖ The initial Rabies vaccine is good for one year, regardless of how old the cat is. Once the cat has had the booster, it is good for three years.
- ❖ The Fvr-cp/Felv is given on a yearly basis once the cat has had a series of vaccinations.
